ROCK Updates

AAOS Meeting Recap

- The MRI classification is finalized, so team at Cincinnati Children's is developing a system that will allow each ROCK member to upload radiographic images that can be de-identified and stored in the online portal.
- All ROCK members will be added as authors on publications, but placement of authors will depend on contribution. Currently working on a standard proposal for ROCK members to initiate new research ideas.
- Discussed potential outreach efforts via patient-centered handouts and cards directing patients to ROCK website.

Penn Cartilage Symposium Recap

- · Dr. Carey served as the Co-Director for Penn's annual Cartilage Symposium, which brought together orthopaedic surgeons, basic scientists, and other providers to discuss the latest techniques and innovations in cartilage repair.
- Dr. Lars Peterson served as the keynote speaker for the event, offering his perspective on cartilage and osteochondral injuries with a focus on Autologous Chondrocyte Implantation (ACI). Drs. Hui, Polousky, and Shea also presented at the event, discussing everything from stem cells to challenging surgical cases to quality, cost, and value of cell-based therapies.

Research Coordinator Conference Call

 ROCK research coordinators had their first conference call to discuss the prospective cohort and randomized controlled trial, emphasize the importance of follow-up, and address any questions regarding enrollment, patient tracking, RC turnover, etc. If you do not have an RC, email Eileen (storeye@email.chop.edu) for meeting minutes.

Industry/Financial Update

- 1. Allosource Commitment for 50K per year (in 25K installments every 6 months) for 3 years.
- 2. Vericel Agreed to provide corporate sponsorship 25K in 2016 pending.

Future Directions

- ROCK elbow expansion (ROCKET) Carl Nissen has collected several capitellar OCD cases, but needs more cases (full set of x-rays, MRIs, arthroscopy pictures for each case) to establish classification systems. He is also working with Don Bae (BCH) to create forms for REDCap and to allow for a series of validation steps similar to those for the knee.
- International Dr. Ganley and Dr. Wall are developing a strategy for international involvement, which includes recruiting from South America and initiating a journal club that can facilitate discussions with international colleagues across time zones.
- Form changes The prospective cohort forms are undergoing changes to incorporate features requested by industry support, genetic samples, and all focal cartilage defects. Please email Evan (Evan.Bannister@uphs.upenn.edu) with any other suggestions for form changes.





Randomization

- 1. Call Kyna Donohue (office number 857-218-3272 or cell number 857-321-1497) or Greg Myer (cell number 513-404-4382). Details are also available on the ROCK Website.
- 2. Enroll and randomize yourself (option #1 may not be available without planning ahead)
 - 1. Enroll patient
 - https://rockstudygroup.research.cchmc.org/auth/login
 - · Select 'Enroll patient' from the tab on top of the page
 - · Enter site, Patient ID (only include last 3 digits and laterality)

 - · Prompted to enter eligibility criteria, including activity restriction and NWB
 - 2. Randomize Patient

 - Must use SURGEON ACCOUNT to randomize.
 - · From login, select 'Patients' from tab on top of the page
 - · Find the patient ID
 - · Select corresponding blue 'Randomize Patient' button on the right side of the page
